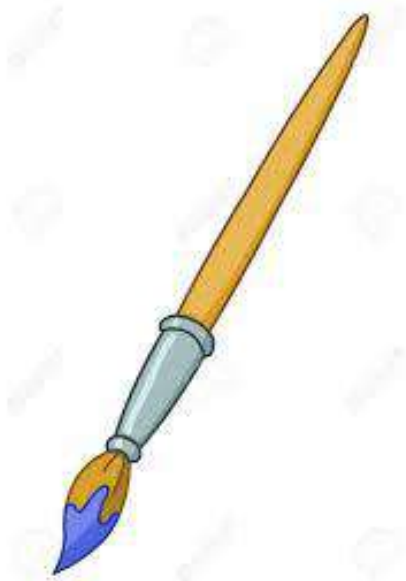




Activity 1: Flashcards

I use a **paintbrush** to paint a picture.



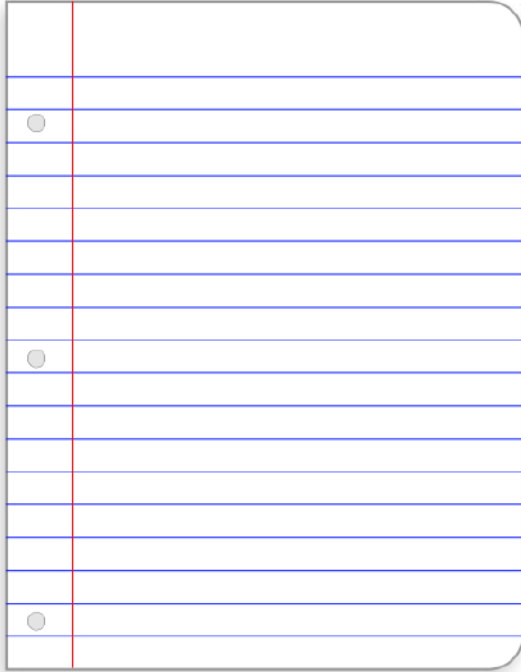
I keep all my supplies in my **pencil bag**.

I can measure with my **ruler**.



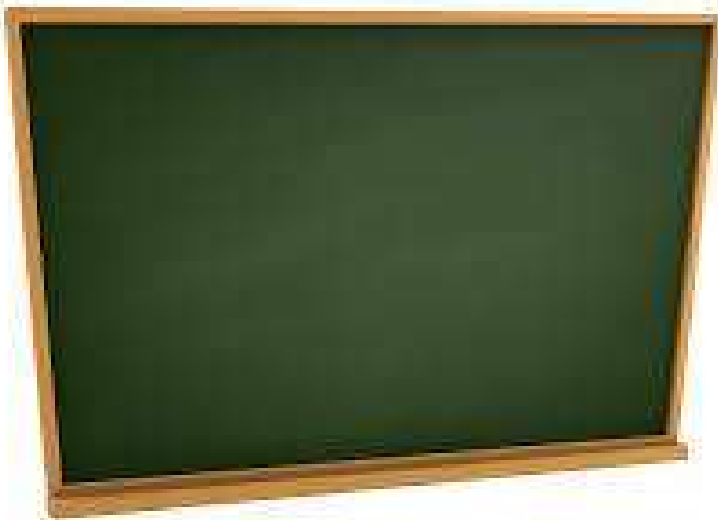
I take notes in my **notebook**.
